- Ropes will be provided.
- 7 Players per team
- \$20 team entry fee. (checks payable to: Wiregrass United Way)

- All players must wear proper shoes, pants/shorts, and shirt. Team shirts optional. No cleats or spikes are allowed.
- Gloves are not provided but strongly recommended.
- Double Elimination Tournament.
- Lineup Roster will be completed and signed waiver by each player at check-in.
- There will be no change to the team roster after the starts of the first game.
- Referee will control the game.
- Do not taunt or bait opponents and refrain from using foul or abusive language.
- When a player or players have their elbow below knee level while pulling the rope it's considered "locking" and is grounds for disqualification.
- When a player or players touch the ground for a long period of time it's considered a foul and can result in disqualification. This is a judgement call of the referee.
- Referee will control the game.
- Check-in begins are 5:00 pm. Round one tournament time: 5:30 pm; Round two at 6:30 pm and the Finals at 7:30 pm.

START OF GAME:

- Team players will align themselves along the rope in alternating positions.
- The referee will give the commands.
- On the command "PICK UP THE ROPE!" all players will pick up the rope with both hands. At no time will any player wrap the rope around their hand, arm, or body.
- On the command "TAKE THE STRING!" all players will take the slack off the rope to make it straight. But, will listen to the referee to adjust the rope so that the center marking is above the center line.
- On the command, 'PULL!' or when the whistle is blown indicating when to pull, the teams will start pulling.
- Teams will continue to pull until the OUTER marking on the rope is pulled across the center line. The referee will decide when this occurs and will declare the winner of that pull.
