



2016 Coloring Contest Rules for Senior Citizens

1. This contest must take place at a retirement center, city hall, or meeting place of a senior group.
2. Each group will send 5 winners from each age group. These winners are considered the preliminary winners.
3. Send the entries back to a) the National Peanut Festival office or b) Tracy Creel, chairperson of the coloring contest: Preliminary winners coloring pages must be received by Wednesday, October 26, 2016. 4. The winners will be notified if they have provided contact information on the coloring contest page. To be contacted as a winner, it is vital that all information is provided. This information will be hidden from public view at the fair grounds. Only participant's name and age division will show.
5. The winners will be contacted by phone or fax through the center they participated. Prizes and coloring sheets may be picked up from the fairgrounds on Monday, November 14, 2016 from (time placed here). Any preliminary winner who would like to have his/her coloring sheet back will need to have a representative contact Tracy Creel concerning pick up.
6. Prizes: There will be a first, second, and third place winner in each age division.

Ages 55-65:

- 1st place winner receives a ribbon and \$15.00
- 2nd place winner receives a ribbon and \$10.00
- 3rd place winner receives a ribbon and \$5.00

Ages 66-75:

- 1st place winner receives a ribbon and \$15.00
- 2nd place winner receives a ribbon and \$10.00
- 3rd place winner receives a ribbon and \$5.00

Ages 76 & above

- 1st place winner receives a ribbon and \$15.00
- 2nd place winner receives a ribbon and \$10.00
- 3rd place winner receives a ribbon and \$5.00
