### General Rules and Regulations

1. Entries should be brought to the Premium Exhibits Building at the NPF Fairgrounds on Thursday, November 3, 2016 from 4:00 – 7:00 P.M.
2. Entry forms should be turned in with your entry. **Pre-registration is not necessary.** An unlimited number of entries are allowed in each lot, but one family may win only 2 awards per lot.
3. All entries must remain on display until Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup>. Entries may be picked up from the NPF Premium Exhibit Building Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM. Any entry not picked up by 10:00 AM on Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup> will become the property of the National Peanut Festival. Please refer to the attached map for pick-up instructions.
4. Premium checks may be picked up with your entries at the same times on Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup>. Any checks not picked up by 10:00 AM on Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup> will be mailed from the NPF Office to the name and address given on the entry form. Please be sure to include all the information requested on the entry form, and make sure it is legible. Premium checks are issued based upon judges scoring sheets, not ribbon placement.
5. Department Chairmen will be responsible for checking on your exhibit daily. All exhibits will be UNMANNED.
6. There shall be no soliciting of funds in the exhibit area.
7. Reasonable caution in the safeguarding of all exhibits will be exercised, but the Festival Staff CANNOT assume responsibility for any loss or damage incurred.
8. No exhibitor tickets will be given for the items entered.
9. All baked goods must have at least 50% honey as the sweetener and must be in gallon zip-loc bags. Please submit the recipe with all baked goods entered.
10. PLEASE USE NON-RETURNABLE TRAYS FOR BAKED GOODS.
11. Lot 04 (Misc. Hive Products) entries must state what hive products are used on the entry form.
